Darling his heirs and assigns forever, my unconditional
headright certificate of three hundred and twenty acres
of land issued to me by the Board of Land Commissioners
of Harris County No. 470, dated second day of November
A.D. 1846, together with all the rights, privileges and appur-
-tenances therunto belonging or in any wise incident or
appertaining. To have and to hold the aforesaid
land certificate with all the rights and privileges to
the same belonging to the said Thomas Darling his heirs
and assigns forever. And I the said J. W. King
declare that said certificate belongs to me that I have
good right to sell and dispose of the same, and I
hereby agree to warrant and forever defend the title
to the said Thomas Darling his heirs executors admin-
-istrators and assigns against any and all claims
whatsoever.

conveyed to me by said King by deed dated 12th
day of November 1846 which said deed and Certificate


