That William Gray having served faithfully and honorably in the army of the Republic of Texas, for the term of Twenty Five Months, from the eighteenth day of March 1839 until the fourth day of May 1841, and having received an honorable discharge

is entitled to Two hundred & forty Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his CERTIFICATE.

And the said William Gray is entitled to hold said Land; or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same; and to exercise all rights of ownership over it.
