That *Moses Ellison* having served faithfully and honorably for the term of *two* Months from the *10th* day of *October* until the *twelfth* day of *December* 1835 and having *been honorably discharged* is entitled to *three hundred thirty* Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his CERTIFICATE.

And the said *Moses Ellison* is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same, and to exercise all rights of ownership over it.

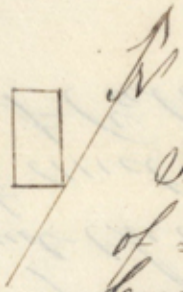
