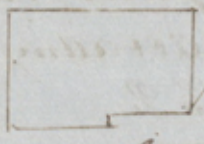

missioner of the General Land office, a Patent for
one third of a league of land to which I am en-
titled by Law, and by virtue of Certificate N^o 247
issued from the County of Harrisburg on the
third day of August 1823

And also, in my name to execute the necessary receipts for the
same, hereby ratifying and confirming all and singular the acts
and doings of him my said Attorney in the premises.
