interest in a land certificate of
three hundred and twenty acres
granted in my favour by the board
of land commissioners for the County
of ^{Memard} Liberty and numbered one
as a single man and having
complied by this time with the
conditions prescribed by law

and having resided three years
in the republic do now and
forever transfer unto said William
Lampkins his Heirs or assigns
all my claim unto said land to
locate the said land at his pleasure
and expend to demand from the proper
offices of government an unconditional
certificate if the law & will permits
him to receive it or if not I William
McKinney bind myself to afford such
assistance and make such proof as
to ^{procure} ~~enable~~ a patent and the said
Wm Lampkins may demand and
receive from the commissioners of
the general land office a patent for
the said land in his own name
if practicable or if not to receive
it in my name and should such

patent issue by law in my own
name there and in that case
I William McKinney bind myself
my Heirs administrators and execu-
tors to make to said Wm Lampkins
his Heirs or assigns a good and
sufficient title for the land above
referred to in the penal sum of
five hundred dollars
