

that I Nathaniel C. Raymond of the County and
Republic aforesaid for and in consideration of the
sum of twenty five dollars to me in hand paid
by William Lankin the receipt of which is
hereby acknowledged have this day bargained
sold alienated assigned and Conveyed and by these
presents do bargain sell alienate assign and Convey
in fee simple all my right title and interest in
and to my unconditional head right Certificate
for three hundred and twenty acres of Land
it being Class 3^d and No 47th issued by the board
of Land Commissioners for the County of Milam
on the 5th day of June 1843 together with all and
singular the rights and privileges thereunto belonging
or in any wise appertaining to have and to hold the
same to his own proper use and benefit and to his
heirs and assigns forever and I hereby give to the
said William Lankin full power to locate the
same at his pleasure or to use or dispose of in
any way he may see proper and I give him full power
to apply to the proper officers of Government for a
patent to the Land when located and to receive the
same in his own name if the laws will permit or
if the laws will not permit to receive the patent
in my name and therefore I bind myself my
heirs and assigns in the penal sum of five hundred
dollars to make out the said William Lankin his
heirs or assigns a good and sufficient legal title
to the land as soon as it is patented the above
Contract being completed with this bond shall
be null and void otherwise to remain in full
force and virtue Given under my hand and seal
