ned, unto the said Cornelius Adriance his heirs and as-
signs forever; and I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors
and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and
singular the said premises, unto the said Cornelius Adriance
his heirs and assigns, against every person whomsoever, lawfully
claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.


