That *William Hoyt* — having served faithfully and honorably for the Term of *Seventeen* — Months, from the *twenty fourth* — day of *November 1839* — until the *Eighth* — day of *May 1841* — and having been honorably discharged — is entitled to *two hundred and forty* — Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his CERTIFICATE.

And the said *William Hoyt* — is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same; and to exercise all rights of ownership over it.

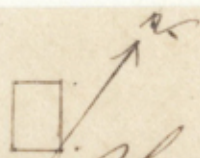
