According to Law that he arrived in this County
before May of the Year Eighteen Hundred and Thirty five
that he was a single man at the date of the de-
claration of Independence, but has since married -
that he has contributed to the support and defense
and support of the Country - and entitled to Two
Thirds of a League and one Labor of Land (He
having previously obtained a certificate for one
Third of a League of Land) Upon the Condition
of paying at the rate of Three ⁵⁰/₁₀₀ dollars for every
Labor of Irri-gable Land Two ⁵⁰/₁₀₀ dollars for every
Labor of Arable or Temporal Land and One ²⁰/₁₀₀ dol-
lar for every labor of Pasture Land which may
be contained in the Survey, Secured to him by this
Certificate - Given under our hands this 4th
day of October 1838 -
