THAT Thomas Osborne having served faithfully and honorably for the term of Three months from the Fifth day of July 1834 until the Fifth day of October 1834 and being honorably discharged from the Army of Texas is entitled to three hundred twenty Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his Certificate.

And the said Thos Osborne is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same, and to exercise all rights of ownership over it.

This Certificate will be transferable by Endorsement, with a Deed, before any competent Authority, with Witnesses to the same.
