Robertson* having served faithfully and honourably for the Term of *9* <sup>mo</sup> Months, from the *Seventeenth* day of *June* 1836 until the *University fifth* day of *November* 1836 and having been honourably discharged by Capt. *Boales* is entitled to *Three hundred and twenty* Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his CERTIFICATE.

And the said *E. S. Robertson* is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same; and to exercise all rights of ownership over it.

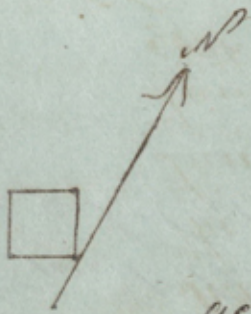
