That *Miram Lee Sr. et al* having served faithfully and honorably for the term of *Three* Months from the first day of *March* 1836 - until the first day of *June* 1836 and having been honorably discharged is entitled to *Three hundred Twenty* Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his CERTIFICATE.

And the said *Miram Lee Sr. et al* or his heirs is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same, and to exercise all rights of ownership over it.

this *Third* day of *May* 1839.
