 as a homestead for the period of  
 three consecutive years beginning  
 on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of July 1871, that he is  
 a married man with a family and  
 makes this affidavit for the purpose  
 of obtaining a ~~home~~ title to the  
 same, for a homestead under an  
 act for the benefit of actual  
 occupants of the Public Lands  
 approved May 26<sup>th</sup> 1873 and that  
 he has not a homestead other  
 than the above -
