 de Cerrova of the County of ~~Washington~~ State aforesaid, all my rights titles
 interest claim and demand in and to my headright No. 283
 granted to me by the board of Land Commissioners for the County of Galveston
 for two hundred and forty acres of land, and dated the 9th day of July A.D.
 1847 together with all and singular the rights privileges, incidents and
 appurtenances to the same belonging or in any wise connected
 appertaining. It shall and to hold the said above described certificate
 and appurtenances, together with all the rights thereby accruing unto him
 the said Jacob de Cerrova his heirs and assigns forever, that
 I do hereby bind myself my self my heirs executors and administrators
 to warrant and forever defend the said above described certificate and
 appurtenances unto him the said Jacob de Cerrova his heirs and assigns
 against the claims or claims of all persons whomsoever lawfully
 claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

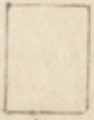
