

Know all men by these presents That I
Moses King of the State and county aforesaid, for and in consid-
eration of the sum of One hundred dollars to me in hand
paid by Paul Messfelder of the county and State aforesaid
the receipt of which I do hereby acknowledge have grant-
ed, bargained sold transferred, released and conveyed, And by
these presents do grant, bargain, sell, transfer, release and
convey unto the said Paul Messfelder his heirs and
assigns forever, My unconditional head right certificate
for 640 acres of Land No 149 - 3^d Class. issued by the Board of Land
Commissioners for Jasper county, on the 27 day of October 1845
and predicated on a conditional certificate granted me
by the Board of Land Commissioners for Jasper county, on
the 4th day of January 1840. for 640 acres of Land No 149 -
2^d Class. both of which certificates are hereto annexed. With
all and singular the rights, privileges, uses, tenements, in-
herediments, and appurtenances to the same in any man-
ner or way belonging. To have and to hold the above descri-
bed certificates to the whole and sole use of said P. Messfelder
his heirs and assigns forever. And I do further warrant
said certificate to be good and genuine free from any
incumbrances whatsoever, binding my self my heirs and
assigns to make such other and further conveyances as may
be necessary to secure the full, perfect and complete
ownership of said Messfelder his heirs and assigns in
and to any land or lands that has or may be located
and surveyed by virtue and authority of the same.
