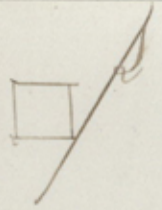

 N 58 E 12 varas Thence S 60 W 840 varas crossed
 a branch 950 varas to the S W corner
 from which a Live Oak marked A bears
 N 36 E 66 varas Thence N 30 W 950 varas

Proof of Settlement under Homestead Act.

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The State of Texas,
County of Basque

BEFORE ME, the undersigned, District Clerk in and for the County aforesaid, this day came and personally appeared David Olive, a resident citizen of said County, who being by me duly sworn, declares that he is a bona fide settler upon (160) acres of vacant public land, situated in said County, and surveyed for David Olive, on the 16th day of Jan'y. 1872, by L. H. Scrutepfield a Surveyor of said County; that he has occupied and improved the same as a Homestead for a period of three consecutive years, beginning on the 16th day of Jan'y. 1872, that he is a married man, and that he makes this affidavit for the purpose of obtaining a title to the same for a Homestead, under an Act supplementary to "An Act for the Benefit of Actual Occupants of the Public Lands," approved May 26th, 1873, and Acts prior thereto; and that he has not a Homestead other than the above.

AND also at the same time came and personally appeared, John Hanna and A. A. Loder, two credible resident citizens of said County, to me well known, who being duly sworn, depose and say that David Olive, the person first above named in this affidavit, has actually settled upon and cultivated as a Homestead, the land surveyed for him on the 16th day of Jan'y. 1872, by the Surveyor aforesaid, for the period of three years, and they nor either of them have any interest in the said land.
