This is to certify that Davis
Campbell personally appeared before the Board of
Land Commissioners for Walker County. And proved to
us according to Law. That he emigrated to the Republic of
Texas previous to the first day of January 1842. That he had
resided within the Republic three years and done and per-
formed all the duties required of him as a citizen - That he
is a single man, and that he has never received a
certificate for the quantity of land for which he now
applies. Is entitled to an unconditional grant of
320 Acres of Land in accordance with an Act of
Congress Approved 15th January 1843.

Given under our hands at Huntsville
the 17th day of August. A.D. 1846.

the receipt of which I do hereby acknowledge. have granted,
bargained, sold, released, transferred and conveyed, And do by
these presents, grant, bargain, sell, release, transfer and convey
unto said Paul Mersfelder his heirs and assigns forever
my unconditional head right certificate for 320 Acres of
land N^o 14 issued by the Board of Land Commissioners
for Walker County on the 17th day of August 1846
together with all and singular, the rights, privileges, uses
advantages, tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances to
the same belonging or in any manner of way incident or
appertaining. To have and to hold the above described land
right certificate with any and ^{all} land or lands that has been
or may be located and surveyed by virtue and authority of
the same, to the whole and sole use and benefit of the said
Paul Mersfelder his heirs and assigns forever. And
I do further authorize and empower the said Mersfelder
his heirs or assigns to ask for demand and receive from
the Commissioners of the General Land office any patents
patents that of right should issue for lands located
and surveyed by virtue and authority of said certificate
