of Land out of the Public domain, and is
improving the same as his homestead and
has no other said Land being situated in the

the town of Meridian on the west side of the
Bosque river, and more particularly described
by the accompanying Field notes.

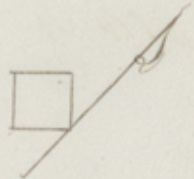

The State of Texas } Field notes of a survey
 County of Bosque } of 160 acres of land made
 for Thomas T. Loader it being the quantity
 of land to which he is entitled by virtue
 of compliance with Preemption law passed
 by the Legislature August 12th 1870 Said
 land is situated on the west side of the
 Bosque River about ~~2~~ miles N ~~64~~ W from
 the town of Meridian.

Beginning No. 419
 runs from the SW corner of a 160 acre
 survey made for W. L. Bateman for
 the NW corner of this survey a pile
 of rocks in prairie. Thence S 30 E 750
 runs to the SW corner from which a
 Live Oak marked X bears N 27 W 100 runs
 Thence N 60 E 1204 runs passing NW
 corner of George Gipsens NW corner
 to the SE corner a pile of rocks in prairie
 Thence N 30 W 750 runs to the NE corner
 a pile of rocks Thence S 60 W 1204
 runs to the beginning.

Proof of Settlement under Homestead Act.

The State of Texas,
County of Bosque

BEFORE ME, the undersigned, District Clerk in and for the County aforesaid, this day came and personally appeared Thos. A. Loader a resident citizen of said County, who being by me duly sworn, declares that he is a bona fide settler upon 1160 acres of vacant public land, situated in said County, and surveyed for Thos. A. Loader on the 20 day of Jan'y 1872, by L. H. Southfield a Surveyor of said County; that he has occupied and improved the same as a Homestead for a period of three consecutive years, beginning on the 20 day of Jan'y 1872 that he is a married man - and that he makes this affidavit for the purpose of obtaining a title to the same for a Homestead, under an Act supplementary to "An Act for the Benefit of Actual Occupants of the Public Lands," approved May 26th, 1873, and Acts prior thereto; and that he has not a Homestead other than the above.

AND also at the same time came and personally appeared, B. A. Yuley and S. D. Martin, two credible resident citizens of said County, to me well known, who being duly sworn, depose and say that Thos. A. Loader the person first above named in this affidavit, has actually settled upon and cultivated as a Homestead, the land surveyed for him on the 20 day of Jan'y 1872, by the Surveyor aforesaid, for the period of three years, and they nor either of them have any interest in the said land.
