

Witnesseth, that the said, Norman Green, for and
in consideration of the sum of Six hundred and forty Dollars
to him Cash in hand, paid by the said, William Palmer,
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and acquitted
at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents,
hath given granted bargained and sold and for the Consider-
ation above named does, hereby give grant bargain sell alien
Convey Confirm, and deliver to the said, William Palmer
and to his heirs and assigns forever, all my right title and
Claim in and to Six hundred and forty Acres of Land,
being the same that I acquired, as my legal right, Certificate,
No 358, granted and issued to me on the Eleventh day
of January A D 1840, signed Martin Parmer Chief Justice,
Wm H Stark Associate & J Parker Clerk, and for further
particulars reference may be had to the Certificate hereto
attached, said Certificate issued to me at the Town of Jasper,
on the day and date above said, herewith, submitted sold and delivered
and I the said, Norman Green, do by these presents, fully authorize
and empower the said, Palmer, — to locate and have
the same lawfully surveyed, to pay for and discharge, all and every
fee that may exist, or arise, in and about the doing of the same. —
And do further give authority, and power to my said Attorney for
me and in my name place and stead to pay up and fully satisfy
and discharge — all and every thing of the Government fee, and other
Charges, and expenses incident, to the procurement of my patent, from
the Government, To hold the same and to use, sell alienate and Convey the
whole or any part of said Certificate or land after surveyed, to any person
or persons, and at any price or prices he may please, And afterwards to hold
use and enjoy the proceeds arising therefrom to his own use and for

the benefits of his heirs forever. And thus to sign my name
and generally and specially to do every act and thing necessary to the mak-
ing executing & confirming of a perfect Deed, or deeds of Conveyance, to
the purchasers, And I the said Norman Green, for the Consideration above
named, shall and will forever warrant and defend, the right title and claim
of said Certificate or Land, to the said Palmer his heirs,

and assigns forever, and further authorized the Commissioners of the General Land
office to Issue a Patent to said Certificate in the name of, the said

Palmer his heirs or assigns In testimony whereof I hereunto

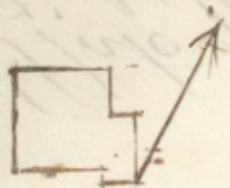
