day of *May* 1836 until the *Third* day of

June 1837 and having been honorably discharged from the Army is entitled to *Twelve hundred eighty* Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his CERTIFICATE.

And the said *William Lawrence* is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same, and to exercise all rights of ownership over it.

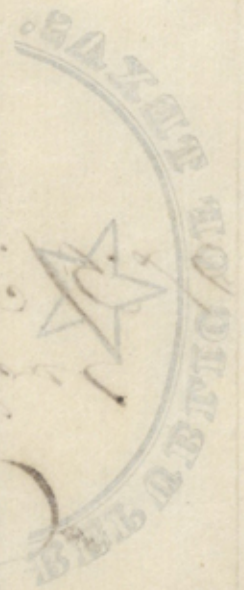

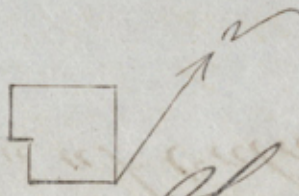

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, *William Lawrence*
for and in consideration of the sum of *Two hundred* dollars, to me
in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, and so far as the ability
exists in me, delivered possession of, to *John Toliver and Joseph*
Harlan twelve hundred and eighty acres of land
to which I am entitled as a *Volunteer* in the **REPUBLIC OF TEXAS.** And I
authorise the said *Toliver and Harlan* their heirs or assigns, to locate the said
Amount of land, to which I am entitled as a *Volunteer* in any
part of the Republic that they may deem proper; and to call upon the proper officer, who is hereby authorised
to issue to the said *Toliver and Harlan* the necessary title to the same.

And I authorise the said *Toliver and Harlan* their heirs or assigns, to
enter upon, when located, said land, and to use and enjoy, and dispose of the same as his own property,
acquired by a just and legal title.

AND WHEREAS, There is no Notary present, I sign the same in presence of the undersigned wit-
nesses, in order, and for the purpose of making it a Notarial act, with executive force, having the same
qualities as a final judgment; and I vest in the judge of the jurisdiction in which said land may be located
full and ample authority to act on this instrument, for the purpose of carrying it into effect.
