Eighteen hundred and thirty six and that he is a Single Man and entitled to One third of a Section of LAND, upon the condition of paying at the rate of five dollars for every labor of irrigable land, Three <sup>50¢</sup> dollars for every labor of temporal or arable land, Two <sup>40¢</sup> dollars for every labor of pasture land, which may be contained in the Survey secured to him by this Certificate.

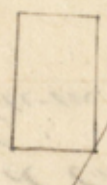

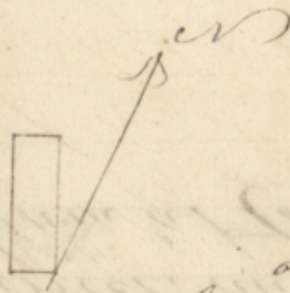
