KNOW ALL MEN TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

THAT Wendell P. Russell having served faithfully and honorably for the term of nineteen months from the twenty seventh day of April 1836 until the fourth day of December 1837 and being honorably discharged from the Army of Texas is entitled to two hundred and eighty Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his Certificate.

And the said W. P. Russell is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same, and exercise all rights of ownership over it.

This Certificate will be transferable by Endorsement, with a Deed, before any competent authority, with witnesses to the same.

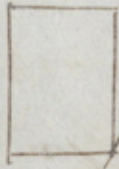
