This is to Certify, that Theurs of Obichah Dodson has appeared before us, the **BOARD OF LAND COMMISSIONERS** FOR THE COUNTY OF *Norrisburg* and proved according to law, that he arrived in this country in *Eighteen hundred and twenty Eight* — and that he was a man of family and entitled to *One Section* of **LAND**, upon the condition of paying at the rate of *Three 5/100 dollars* — for every labor of irrigable land, *Two 5/100 dollars* — for every labor of temporal or arable land, *One 2/100 dollar* — for every labor of pasture land, which may be contained in the Survey secured to him by this Certificate.

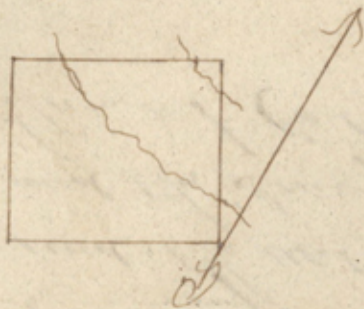
