his name or his heirs or assigns. according to law. and to exercise
full and lawfully possession of the right hereby granted to the
said certificate and the land ^{located} and by these presents
unto the said Wubling his heirs and assigns in these premises
will warrant and defend whereunto I have set my
hand and seal this the sixth day of June 1846

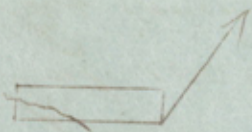
