THIS IS TO CERTIFY, that *Wodan S. Crane* has appeared before the Board of Land Commissioners for the County of San Augustine, and proved according to law that *he* arrived in this Republic *before the declaration of Independence* and that *he* is a *single man* and entitled to *one third of a League* of land, upon the condition of paying at the rate of *Seven Dollars* for every labor of Irrigable land *Five Dollars* for every labor of temporal or arable land *Two Dollars and forty Cents* for every labor of pasture land which may be contained in the survey secured to *him* by this certificate.

The first DAY OF *February* 1838.

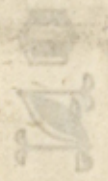

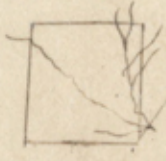
