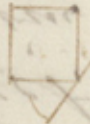

Together with all and singular the ways woods waters water courses rights
liberties priviledges hereditaments and appurtenances what so ever there
unto belonging or in any wise appertaining and also all the estate right
title and interest property claim and demand what so ever of me
and my heirs in Law or equity or otherwise howsoever of in to or out
of the same Certificate of six hundred and forty acres To have and to hold
the said Certificate and to have it surveyed or to dispose of the same
at his will and pleasure and the said Richling his heirs and assigns are
hereby authorized to have the patent issued in his or their name or names
if the Laws will permit, as assigns, I Bind my self my heirs executors or
administrators to furnish the said Richling his heirs and assigns with
all necessary Prooff or documents that may be necessary to procure from
the proper department of Government a complete and legal patent
vesting all right title and interest into the said Richling his heirs and
assigns in the full enjoyment use and occupation of the land which may be ob-
tained by virtue of the survey or survey made upon the authority of said
Certificate and by these presents will warrant and defend the said Richling
