This is to certify that *William Hull* has appeared before us, the BOARD OF LAND COMMISSIONERS FOR THE COUNTY OF GALVESTON, and proved according to law that he emigrated to the Republic of Texas in the month of *August* A. D. 1835 that he resided in and was an actual citizen of said Republic three years and performed all the duties required of him as a citizen, that he is a *single* man, and that he has never heretofore obtained a certificate or headright for land. He is therefore entitled to an unconditional grant of *Six* hundred and *forty* acres of LAND in accordance with an act of Congress approved 16th January, A. D. 1843.

Given under our hands at the City of Galveston, the *14* day of *November* A. D. 184*6*

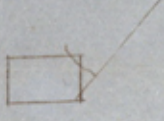

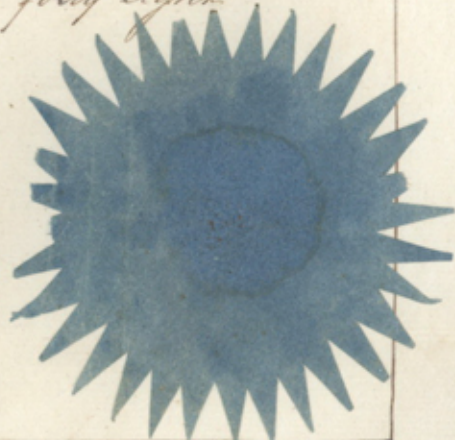
