And the said William Murray is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same, and to exercise all rights of ownership over it.

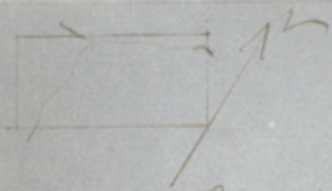

 -vs- No. 2257 :: on this the 13th day of
 Eliphalet Harlem Jr. et. al. September A.D. 1901, this
 cause was regularly called for trial, and the parties, plaintiffs
 and defendants, in person and by attorneys appeared and announced
 ready for trial, that the plaintiff, Mrs. Maude
 H Green, who owns and is entitled to, (5/7) five sevenths, of
 all the lands described in her petition and that the defendants,
 James Harlem, E Harlem, Jr. Robert Harlem and Mrs. Effie May
 Martin, nee Harlem-- who owns and are entitled to two sevenths
 of said land ought to recover of and from the defendants, Wallis
 Landes & Co. ; C. Paulson and J.S. Rizer all of the lands sued
 for and against the defendant F.O. Harris, on his disclaimer
 on all the lands sued for and against all the defendants estab-
 lishing the boundary line of the Wm. Murray survey and found
 and claimed by the plaintiff and her Co-Plaintiffs.

It is therefore ordered adjudged and decreed by the


