This is to certify that Preston Pivhaves
has appeared before us the board of land
Commissioners for said county and proved
according to law that he arrived in this
country in the year 1833 that he
is a man of family and entitled to the
additional quantity of two thirds and one
labor of land under the condition of paying
at the rates of \$ 1.20 for each labor
of pasture land \$ 2.50 for each labor of tem-
peral or arable land and \$ 3.50 for each
labor of irrigable land which may be
contained in the Survey secured to him
by this Certificate.

of Austin this 3rd of June 1839.

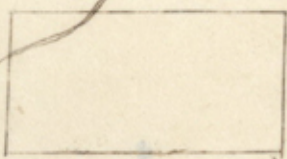
