This is to certify William F. Charles  
has appeared before the Board of Land Commissioners  
for the County of Washington and sworn according to Law that he arrived  
in this Country in the year 1827 that he was a Single man at the date of  
the declaration of Independence but has since married that he has contributed  
to the defence and support of the Country and is entitled to Two Acres of  
a League and one Labor of Land as an Augmentation (He having previously  
received a Certificate for one Third of Land) Upon the condition of his paying  
at the rate of Three Dollars for every labor of Irrigable Land Two Dollars  
for every labor of Temporal or Arable Land and one Dollar for  
every labor of Pasture land which may be <sup>in</sup> ~~found~~ <sup>be</sup> ~~found~~ contained in the survey  
secured to him by this Certificate

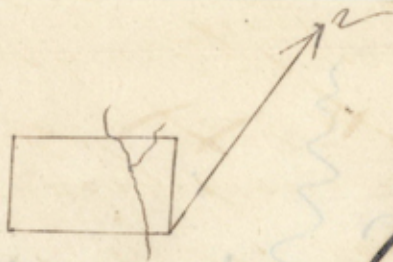

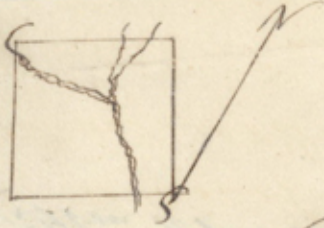

Marshall of the State & County aforesaid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain, sell, and release, unto the said John E. Marshall, Certificate No. 86 issued by the Board of Land Commissioners for Washington County for Two thirds of a League and one Labor of Land dated the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of May 1839, which certificate is herewith delivered and declared part and parcel of this conveyance, Together with all and singular the rights members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the same belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining I have and to hold all and singular the above Certificate together with the Lands Surveyed or that may hereafter be surveyed unto the above mentioned John E. Marshall his heirs or assigns forever - and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said Certificate unto the said John E. Marshall his heirs and assigns against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, Witness my hand and seal (scrawl for seal) this 4<sup>th</sup> day of November 1846 -

Articles of agreement entered

into this day by Jacob De Cordova of the County of Harris of the first part and John S. Marshall of the County of Fayette all of the State aforesaid of the second part, witnesseth that the said party of the first part agrees to locate upon as good vacant lands as are to be found, following described portions of Head right Certificates viz 1/2 380,000 square yards of land by virtue of a Certificate issued by the Commissioner of the Genl. Land Office being the unlocated balance of Head right Certificate granted to John S. Marshall for one league and labor of land, by the Board of Land Commissioners for Austin County. — and 2/3 of a league and one labor of land by virtue of Certificate N: 80 granted to Wm J. Charles for two thirds of a league and one labor of land by the Board of Land Commissioners for Washington County.

The said party of the second part agrees to pay to the said party of the first part part, one third of the whole land specified in the foregoing Certificates being 11,648,888 square yards of land, by the amount of expenses for surveying and procuring patents for the same, being paid by the said party of the first part. And John S. Marshall the said party of the second part, hereby authorizes the Commissioner of the Genl. Land Office, to issue to Jacob De Cordova the party of the first part, his heirs, executor, and assigns full and complete title to the aforesaid 11,648,888 square

Tracts of Land, so soon as the said DeCordova  
shall obtain Patents for the portions of Lands  
concerning to the said John S. Marshall, in  
testimony whereof the Parties set their hands  
and Seals for Seals, the twenty fourth  
day of October A.D. 1846
