 Bounty Land, for which this is his CERTIFICATE.

 is entitled to hold said Land; or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same; and to
 exercise all rights of ownership over it.

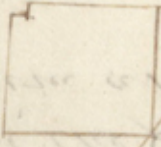
