Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his CERTIFICATE.

And the said *William Motley*, his heirs or assigns is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same, and to exercise all rights of ownership over it.

In Testimony Whereof, I have hereunto set my hand, at *Houston* this *fifth* day of *June* 183*5*

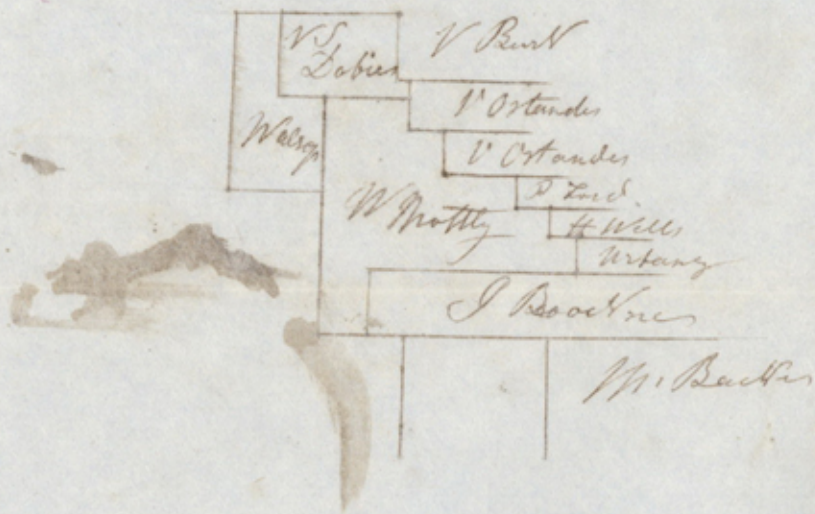
