County of Milam = by these presents
that I James S. Oldham of the County and
Republic aforesaid for and in consideration
of the sum of forty Dollars to me in hand
by Frederick Neibling all of the County and
Republic aforesaid the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged have bargained
and sold and by these presents do bargain
and sell all my right title and interest
in and to all my headright lands that
I am entitled to as an emigrant to
this Republic according to Law - and the
said Neibling is authorized to settle the
same or have it located at his will and
pleasure and will furnish him his heirs
and assigns with all proof or document-
ary evidence to procure from the
proper department of Government a
good and sufficient Patent for the
same to have and to hold the said
headright of Three hundred and twenty
acres when located with all the appur-
tenances thereto belonging or in
any wise appertaining unto the said
Neibling his heirs and assigns to the free
enjoyment use and occupation of
all the lands which may be obtained
by virtue of survey made upon the
Certificate of Twenty hundred and twenty
acres of Land and by these presents
will warrant and defend the same over

said writing his heirs and assigns
against all other persons claiming there-
unto I have set my hand and seal
this the 12th day of January One thousand
eight hundred and forty five
