This is to Certify, that Daniel Roberson has appeared before us, the **BOARD OF LAND COMMISSIONERS** FOR THE COUNTY OF Milam and proved according to law, that he arrived in this country in the year 1834 and that he is a single man and entitled to one third of a League of **LAND**, upon the condition of paying at the rate of Three dollars $\frac{50}{100}$ for every labor of irigable land, Two dollars $\frac{50}{100}$ for every labor of temporal or arable land, one dollar $\frac{20}{100}$ for every labor of pasture land, which may be contained in the Survey secured to him by this Certificate.
