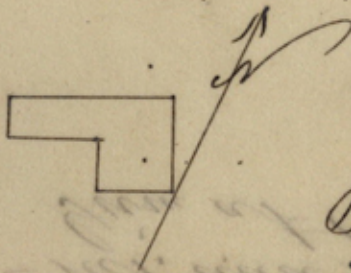

~~the~~ Supplement or remainder of
my Head Right Certificate after
deducting from the same (it being for
one third of a league of Land) Six
hundred and forty acres which is survey
ed and patented on the North prong
of the Bosque River joining John Mc
Sweeney's Head Right as will more
fully appear by reference to said
patent it being No 779 Vol 3 issued
on the eighth day of October 1846
and I do hereby authorize the Com-
missioner of the General Land Office
to issue said Supplement (836 acres) in
the Name of said Caleb M Hubby
and also the patent for the Land when
located
