

This is to certify that Christopher Bryan is entitled to have surveyed, by any legally authorised Surveyor, upon any of the vacant and unappropriated public domain of the State of Texas, Seven Million Seven hundred and fifty eight thousand two hundred and fifty Seven acres (11,758,250.40) of land, it being the unlocated balance of Madright Certificate No. 38 — issued by the Board of Land Com<sup>r</sup> for Liberty Co — to the said Christopher Bryan for his own and labor — of land, dated the first day of February 1838 —


