Proof of Settlement under Homestead Act.

The State of Texas,

BEFORE ME, the undersigned, District Clerk in and for the County aforesaid, this day came and personally appeared Oliver Hagan a resident citizen of said County, who being by me duly sworn, declares that he is a bona fide settler upon One hundred & 60 acres of vacant public land, situated in said County, and surveyed for Oliver Hagan on the 12th day of April 1872, by L. H. Scrutcheville a Surveyor of said County; that he has occupied and improved the same as a Homestead for a period of three consecutive years, beginning on the 12 day of April 1872, that he is Married man and that he makes this affidavit for the purpose of obtaining a title to the same for a Homestead, under an Act supplementary to "An Act for the Benefit of Actual Occupants of the Public Lands," approved May 26th, 1873, and Acts prior thereto; and that he has not a Homestead other than the above.

AND also at the same time came and personally appeared, Peter Pierson and B. B. Swenson, two credible resident citizens of said County, to me well known, who being duly sworn, depose and say that Oliver Hagan the person first above named in this affidavit, has actually settled upon and cultivated as a Homestead, the land surveyed for him on the 12 day of April 1872, by the Surveyor aforesaid, for the period of three years, and they nor either of them have any interest in the said land.

Mountain as my Patent calls for
which is a natural land mark and
will hold the Chain Carriers are
still living here and are prepared

to testify to the original corners
I therefore Protest against the
Surveys made by J. M. Robertson
for John Christidson under Olsen
assignee of A. Pettersen and J. Hauge
as being unlawful & incorrect
as the Court & Jury decided &
restored the land to me taken
by the aforesaid Parties I shall
hold the same even if taken to
higher Courts I hereby send you
this Protest for your further
consideration where there you
attends the land aforesaid run
by Robertson or not remain
