upon One hundred & Sixty (160) acres of
vacant public lands, situated in said
County, and surveyed for Joseph Ragdale
on the 8th day of April 1872 by L. H.
Scratchfield Surveyor of said County, that
he has occupied & improved the same as a
home tract for the period of three ~~years~~
consecutive years, beginning on the 5th day of
September 1871, that he is a married man
with a family, and that he makes this affidavit
for the purpose of obtaining a title to the same
for a homestead, under "An Act for the benefit
of actual occupants of the Public lands" approved
May 26th 1873, and that he has not a home-
stead other than the above - And also at the same
time came & personally appeared L. H. Scratchfield
and William Heffernan, two credible resident
Citizens of said County, to me well known and
being duly sworn, deposed & say that Joseph

Ragdale, the person first above named in
this affidavit has actually settled upon and
cultivated as a homestead the land surveyed
for him on the 8th day of April 1872
by the surveyor aforesaid, for the period of
three (3) years and they nor either of them
have any interest in the said Land.
