# Proof of Settlement under Homestead Act.

BEFORE ME, the undersigned, District Clerk in and for the County aforesaid, this day came and personally appeared Sarah A. Vanzant a resident citizen of said County, who being by me duly sworn, declares that ~~he~~ <sup>she</sup> is a bona fide settler upon one hundred (60) acres of vacant public land, situated in said County, and surveyed for Sarah A. Jones on the 19th day of April 1872, by John A. Schuchfeld a Surveyor of said County; that ~~he~~ <sup>she</sup> has occupied and improved the same as a Homestead for a period of three consecutive years, beginning on the 19th day of April 1872, that ~~he~~ <sup>she</sup> is the head of a family and that ~~he~~ <sup>she</sup> makes this affidavit for the purpose of obtaining a title to the same for a Homestead, under an Act supplementary to "An Act for the Benefit of Actual Occupants of the Public Lands," approved May 26th, 1873, and Acts prior thereto; and that ~~he~~ <sup>she</sup> has not a Homestead other than the above.

AND also at the same time came and personally appeared, T. T. Angel and H. W. Click, two credible resident citizens of said County, to me well known, who being duly sworn, depose and say that Sarah A. Vanzant the person first above named in this affidavit, has actually settled upon and cultivated as a Homestead, the land surveyed for ~~him~~ <sup>her</sup> on the 19th day of April 1872, by the Surveyor aforesaid, for the period of three years, and they nor either of them have any interest in the said land.
