Three ^{cents} for every labor of Temporal or Arable Land & two ^{cents} for every labor of Pasture land which may be contained in the survey claimed to him by this certificate

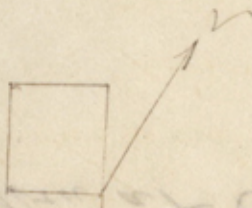
