Said Court do hereby certify that Elijah C. Robertson  
filed his petition for three hundred and sixty nine acres  
of land in the said Court previous to the first day of  
January A.D. 1844 in strict accordance with the act  
of Congress passed February 4<sup>th</sup> 1844 entitled "an  
act supplementary to an act to detect fraudulent  
land certificates and to provide for issuing patents to  
legal claimants" and the formalities prescribed by the  
said act being strictly pursued the verdict of a  
jury was obtained in favor of the said Robertson  
for the said land.

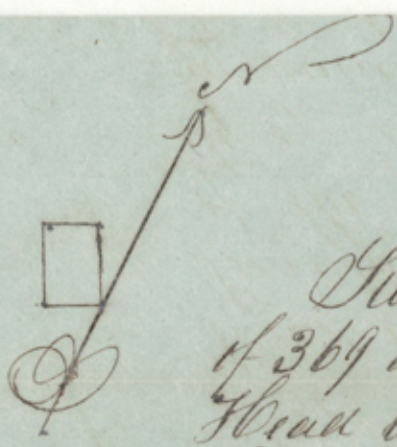
