Dundrards present himself to us on this day the 6<sup>th</sup>  
by sixth of January 1838 and proved to our Satisfaction  
that he is entitled Under the Constitution and Laws of Texas  
to One Labor of Land he having previously obtained one  
League of Land, that he emigrated to Texas in May  
of the year Eighteen Hundred and Thirty five, That he was  
a Citizen at the date of the declaration of Independence  
That he is a married man and that he has rem-  
ained with his family in the Country ever since.

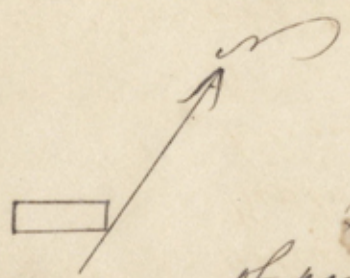
