



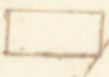

Know all men By these Presents that Gabriel Jackson and wife Virginia Jackson for the consideration of one hundred dollars in hand paid by Frederick Wübbeling the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have this day bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell with full release and confirm unto the said Frederick Wübbeling his heirs and assigns the certificate of one labor of unlocated land it being the right granted by the Board of Land Commissioners in and for Robertson County to Thomas Morrow as part of his headright in the first day of Feb 1838 and by him assigned to the said Jackson on the first day of July 1839 as will appear by the assignment on the back of said certificate for the said Frederick Wübbeling to have and to hold together with all and singular rights and Liberties and privileges what soever there unto belonging or in any wise appertaining and all the estate right title and interest property claim and demand what soever of the whole said certificate the said Wübbeling his heirs and assigns to have and to hold peaceably enjoy or dispose of at pleasure and to have the same located and if the laws will permit the Patent to be issued in the name of said Wübbeling and the title cannot be made in his name then the said Jackson shall make the said Wübbeling his heirs and assigns a bonafide title deed as soon as the patent is obtained from Government for the whole labor of land and the said Jackson his heirs the said hereby granted labor of land unto the said Wübbeling his heirs and assigns against them the said G Jackson his heirs and the said Thomas Morrow his heirs and against all and every other person lawfully claiming or to claim by from under him them or any of them shall and will warrant and for ever defend by these presents
