This is to certify that James Gillespie has appeared before the Board of Land Commissioners for the County of Montgomery, and proved according to law, that he arrived in this country in 1835, and that he is a single man and entitled to One third of a league of land, upon the condition of paying at the rate of Three \$⁰⁰/₁₀₀ for every labor of Irrigable land Two \$⁵⁰/₁₀₀ for every labor of Temporal or Arable land and one \$⁰⁰/₁₀₀ dollar for every labor of Pasture land which may be contained in the Survey secured to said Gillespie by this Certificate.
