and my heirs &c firmly by these presents, Given under  
my hand and seal this 15 day March 1836

The Conditions of the above obligation is  
such that whereas said Gates is by the laws  
of the Country entitled to a headright for a  
league and labor of land, an order of Survey  
for which he has obtained of G. H. Smyth Gov,  
dated October 10. 1835 No 499 and has this  
day, and do by these presents sell and convey unto  
Joseph Row his heirs or assigns all his right and  
claim in and to the said headright, for the  
sum of one hundred <sup>dollars</sup> cash to him in hand paid  
by the said Row, and do hereby (if the laws will  
so permit) <sup>fully authorize</sup> him to receive a title for the same in  
his own name, but if they will not, and the said  
Gates shall, when a title is obtained by the said Row  
for him, make or cause to be made to the said  
Row or his assigns a title in principle to the whole  
of said lands, then this to be void & of no effect  
otherwise to remain in full force & virtue; date as above,
