The proof of occupancy and \$5⁰⁰ patent fee has been sent up some time since; also I send you field notes for 46 acres of land made for C. A. Canuteson. I presume the necessary tracery are all at the Land Office. Issue a patent on this as soon as you can and take \$5⁰⁰ out of my credits for patent fee when issued and forward same to me. If I have neglected anything about the 46 survey in making out the proper I will correct as soon as informed of the fact. How much more of this certificate is there to locate? In reply to your favor of the 24th I will say Daniel C. Swami's is not a new claim. He settled on the land in 1873 or 4 and had it surveyed in 1874 and the surveyor lost the field notes. I think you should issue the patent ~~on it~~. Look at his proof of occupancy and you can see that I am correct. Send patent to me when issued.
