Keith* has appeared before us, the **BOARD OF LAND COMMISSIONERS** FOR THE COUNTY OF HARRISBURG, and proved according to law, that he arrived in this country before the declaration of *Independence* and that he is a *Single man* and entitled to *One third of a League* of **LAND**, upon the condition of paying at the rate of *Five dollars* for every labor of irrigable land, *Three dollars & fifty cents* for every labor of temporal or arable land, *Two dollars & forty cents* for every labor of pasture land, which may be contained in the Survey secured to him by this Certificate.

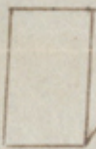

assigns, one third of a league of land
granted as a headright, by the laws of
this Republic to Henry Mailard - of this
County, as appears by the certificate of the
Board of Land Commissioners of this
County, numbered one hundred and ninety-six;
Also one third of a league of land granted
as a headright in the same manner to
John Litcher - of the same county as

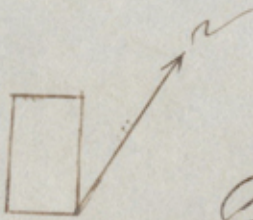

lawful claims of all persons whomsoever, by these presents. And the said Vendor
doth moreover subrogate the said Purchaser to all the rights and actions of war-
ranty which he has or may have, against his own Vendors or
against the Vendors of his Vendors, fully authorizing the said Purchaser
to exercise the said rights and actions in the same manner as he himself
might or could have done.

And the said Belain declares that
he has held the said headrights, by virtue of
a bona fide purchase from each of the original
holders, and he covenants and agrees that
he will warrant and defend that each of
the original holders, was justly and legally
entitled to the said land of his own right,
and that this purchaser shall have the
same right which was theirs, with all
the powers of locating and perfecting a
title which they originally had, he, this
purchaser, taking on himself all the
labor, expense, and risk of locating
and perfecting the title to the same.
