

County to said Shubal Marsh for three fourths of a  
league and one labor of land on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of Feb<sup>r</sup>  
1838. but only recommended (by the Travelling Board  
of Land Com<sup>rs</sup> appointed to detect fraudulent Land  
Certificates &c) for three fourths of a league.
