KNOW ALL MEN TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

THAT Henry Billings having served faithfully and honorably for the term of Eight months from the fourteenth day of July 1837 until the eleventh day of October 1837 and being honorably discharged from the Army by death is entitled to fifteen hundred and twenty Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his Certificate.

And the said Henry Billings is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same, and exercise all rights of ownership over it.

This Certificate will be transferable by Endorsement, with a Deed, before any competent authority, with witnesses to the same.

And now on this day came the parties by their attorneys, and the said defendants each filed in the Court here their answers and return to the complainant's petition and relation, and by consent the matters of Law and fact arising thereon were submitted to the Court; and the Court after hearing the Evidence, doth order adjudge and decree that the Peremptory Mandamus issue as prayed for, and the said James S. Gillett, Adjutant General of the State of Texas, be directed to approve as genuine Bounty Land Warrant N^o. 1387 for Ninety hundred and twenty acres, issued by the Republic of Texas to Henry Billings on the 28th day of December, 1837.

It is further ordered adjudged and decreed that the said Stephen Crosby Commissioner of the General Land Office be and he is hereby ordered, required, and directed to issue to the Civil and legal Representatives of said Henry Billings a Patent in accordance with the filed notes returned into the General Land Office with said Bounty Land warrant by William Armstrong District Surveyor of the Milam Land District. It is further ordered adjudged, and decreed, that the relator pay the costs accruing in this Cause, and that Execution issue therefor.
