Whereas Delilah McCullough

Administratrix of all singular the goods & chattels, rights & credits estate, which were of James McCullough decd at the time of his death did on the day of 1843 file in the office of the Clerk of this Court her petition stating that she as Administratrix as aforesaid for the use & benefit of the heirs of the said James McCullough decd. had received from the Board of Land Commissioners of said County a Certificate for two thirds of a League and one Labor of land as the augmentation head right of the said James McCullough and that the board of Travelling Commissioners had failed to recommend the same for patent.

Whereas a jury empannelled by the said Court to try the said case on this the 26th day of October 1844 rendered their verdict that they found that the said plaintiff was entitled to two thirds of a League and one Labor of land as claimed by her in her said petition & the said Court pronounced judgment thereon accordingly - Now therefore be it known that this Certificate entitles the said Delilah McCullough Administratrix as aforesaid for the use & benefit of the heirs at Law of the said James McCullough decd to two thirds of a League and One Labor of land to be located on the vacant lands of the Republic she paying therefor for every labor secured to her by this Certificate according to its quality the fees due from colonists who emigrated to the Country in the year one thousand eight hundred & thirty four

Witness my hand & private seal the being provided no Seal of the said Court at office this the twenty sixth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & forty four

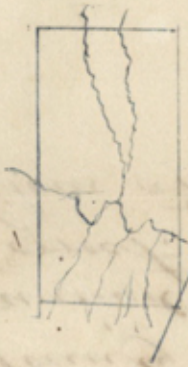
